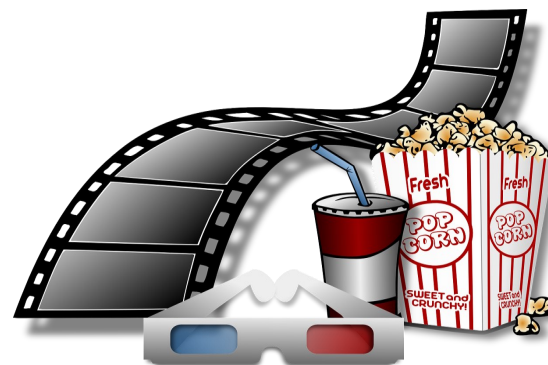

## Rules for Summer Reading

1. Summer Reading starts Tuesday, May 30th and ends Saturday July 22nd at 2:00 P.M. for Birdseye Library.
2. Everyone can participate.
3. Completion requires reading 3 books and completing 2 Library Activities. You may replace the 2 activities with reading 2 more books.
4. Upon completion, present your reading log or Beanstack to us for a completion prize.
5. You will get 5 tickets upon completion that you can enter into prize drawings. Every activity you complete and every book you read beyond completion will reward you an additional ticket. There is no limit on how many books you can read for tickets!
6. Feel free to distribute your tickets however you wish. You can go all in on one prize that you really want, or you can spread them out among several prizes.
7. Drawings will take place on Tuesday, July 25th. You will receive a phone call if your ticket gets drawn.
