The Jasper High School Band, under the direction of Donald Gamble and James Holler, continued to uphold their reputation as an outstanding Southern Indiana band.

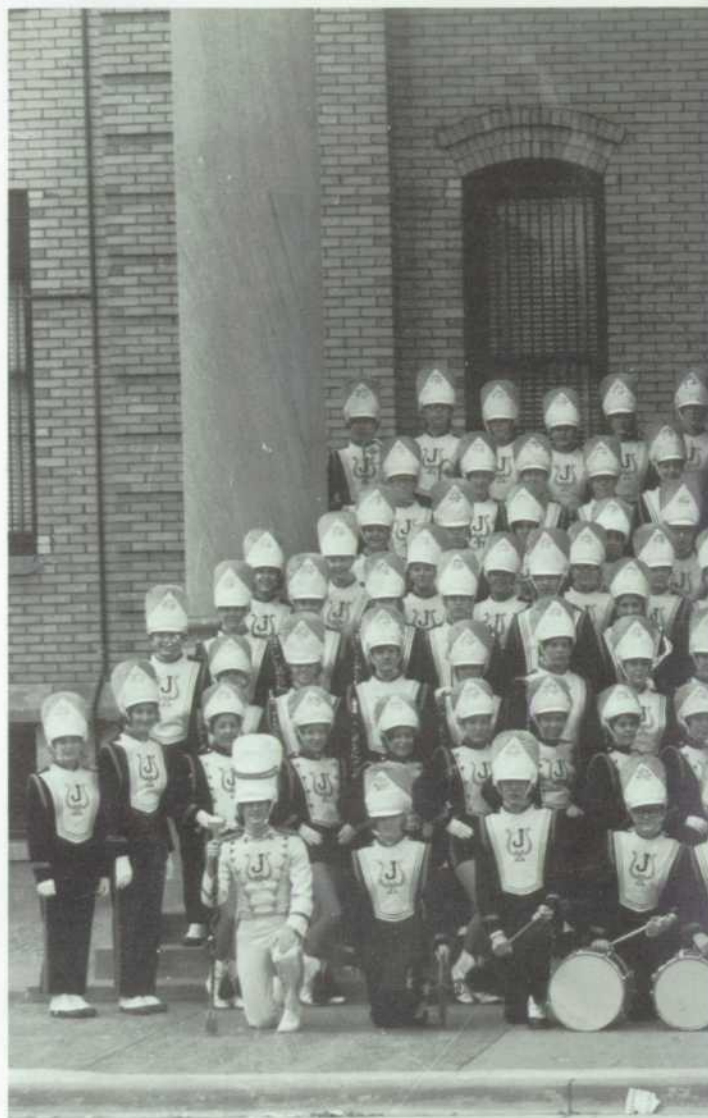
